

GRANITE STATE GYMNASTICS BOOSTER CLUB
BY-LAWS

Article I

Name of the Organization

Section I

The Club will be known as GSG Booster Club.

Article II

Purpose of the Organization

Section I

The object for which this corporation is established is: To promote team spirit, parental involvement and further amateur athletes in their goals by including (but not limited to) need based aide, performance based aide, performance of educational excellence and any other need defined by the board of directors.

Article III

Membership

Section 1

Membership shall be open to all parents/guardians of gymnasts attending Granite State Gymnastics.

It is in the spirit of the Booster Club that all parents/ guardians are encouraged to participate. However, parents and guardians may elect whether or not to participate.

a. Booster Club Membership

1. May attend all general meetings.
2. Have full voting privileges at general member votes.

b. Special Circumstances

1. The Board of Directors reserves the right to review individual situations on a case by case basis.

c. Monthly Meetings

1. GSGBC will hold meetings during which members may Attend and vote on Booster Club business.
2. Meetings will be held the 3rd Wednesday of every month at 6:30pm.

Article IV

Officers and Other Representatives

Section I

The Board of Directors will consist of the following positions:

- a. President
- b. Vice President
- c. Secretary
- d. Treasurer
- e. Level Representatives
 1. Pre-Team Representative
 2. Level 4 Representative
 3. Level 5 Representative
 4. Level 6 Representative
 5. Optionals Representative
 6. Prep – Opt Representative
 7. Boys Team Representative

Article V

Duties of Officers, and Representatives

Section I

Officers

- a. President (two year term)
 1. To oversee the Board of Directors and be the primary liaison between management and the gym/club.
 2. To moderate all official Booster Club meetings.

3. To keep in contact with all board members.
 4. To approve any club checks over \$150.00 per individual item.
 5. To distribute the by-laws at the first meeting of the year to any and all members who wish a copy.
 6. To answer any questions about the by-laws whenever necessary.
 7. To have the deciding vote in the case of a stalemate.
- b. Vice President (two year term)
1. To attend Booster Club meetings.
 2. To exercise the powers of the president in case of their absence or inability to act.
 3. To perform other duties as assigned by the board of directors.
- c. Secretary (two year term)
1. To attend Booster Club meetings.
 2. To take and keep accurate minutes of all Booster Club meetings.
 3. To provide gym management and the club president with copies of the meeting minutes after each and every meeting.
- d. Treasurer (two year term)
1. To attend Booster Club meetings.
 2. To maintain an accurate account of all club funds.
 3. To present a record of those funds at each meeting.
 4. To make deposits and withdrawals when necessary.
 5. To work with the Board of Directors to draft a projected budget at the beginning of each year and to present said budget at the second meeting of the season.
- e. Level Representatives
1. To attend Booster Club meetings.

2. To communicate with level parents/guardians to promote involvement.

Article VI

Nominations and Elections

Club members, who are in good standing with the gym, may be nominated by any club member, including themselves.

The annual voting will occur in June, when each Booster Club member may cast one vote per family for each slated office.

Article VII

Removal and Vacancies

Section I

Removal - Officers may be removed from office by a vote from the Board of Directors.

Section II

Vacancies – A vacancy will be filled by a nomination and an election by the Board of Directors.

Article VIII

Meetings and Meeting Procedures

Board of Directors Meetings

Section I

The President will preside over the meetings according to the predetermined agenda.

Section II

The minutes will be presented for approval or correction.

Section III

The Treasurer's report will be presented for approval or correction.

Section IV

All decisions will be determined by a majority vote of those present.

Section V
Motions

1. After adequate club discussion, any member may make a motion, which must be seconded, to call a vote.
2. Motions pass or fail by majority vote.
3. A motion may be tabled, by a majority vote, to the next club meeting for further discussion and consideration.

Article IX
Amendments

Section I

Amendments to the by-laws may be made in accordance with the following procedures:

Step 1: An amendment may be proposed, and subsequently discussed at any club meeting.

Step 2: Upon discussion of those members present, the proposed amendment will be stated in the minutes of the meeting.

Step 3: The proposed amendment will be considered as part of the subsequent club meeting agenda and open to further discussion prior to a general membership vote. Passage of the amendment requires majority approval by the club members who are in good standing and present. The vote of the club President will break any and all ties.
